

# nwgi - 24" x 32" MDO Sandwich Board

## Layout Guidelines

nwgi - 24" x 32" MDO Sandwich Board

### Make sure you are using the right guide!

nwgi has several different sandwich board models that have **different print sizes**. Using the wrong template will delay your project and will require a new file with the correct size to be submitted.

### What size should I make my file?

Your file should be sized 24.75" x 32.75". The following page contains an actual-size guide that can be placed into your file as a separate layer while you working on your file. PLEASE MAKE THE GUIDE LAYER INVISIBLE IN YOUR SUBMITTED FILE - failure to do so will cause the cut line to be present on the final print.

The guide includes a 1/2" bleed around the print, shown in red. Please bleed your design out to the red perimeter. The black line is the crop-to line. It is highly recommended that you don't have type or essential graphics too near the black cut line because it may get cropped.

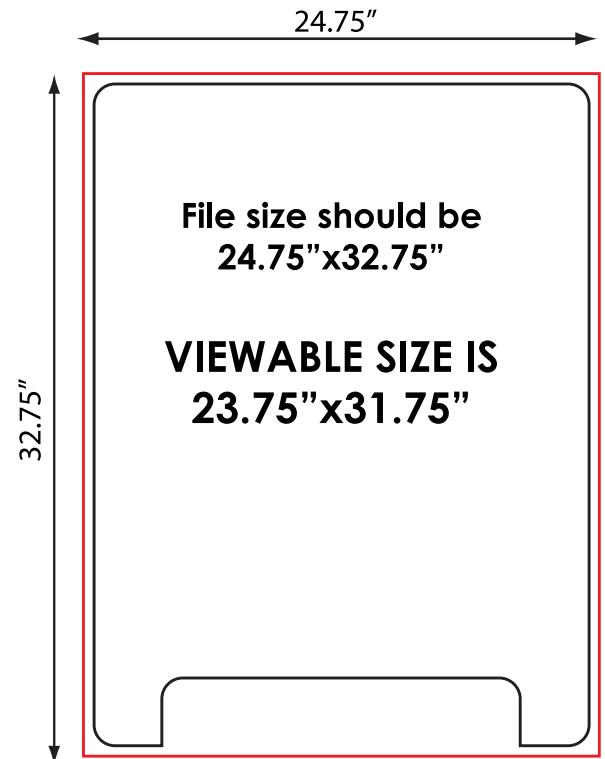
### What Resolution should my files be?

nwgi recommends at least 150ppi at the size your file will be printed.

### What type of file should I submit?

For full color sandwich boards, nwgi recommends creating a PDF using the "Press Quality" setting. Make the guide layer invisible. The PDF file you submit should be 24.75"x32.75".

For cut vinyl sandwich boards, a vectorized EPS, Illustrator file may be submitted. ALL FONTS MUST BE CONVERTED TO OUTLINES AND ALL GRAPHICS MUST BE VECTORIZED -- NO RASTER GRAPHICS For specific file prep tips, color choices, and limitations please refer to our cut vinyl file guide.
